



# **SPORTS GRADUATE**

Fixed term contract to commence 1st September 2024 until July 2025

This is a fixed-term position, predominantly focused on teaching and coaching sport. It is a Monday to Friday schedule (term time only) with minimal weekend commitments, allowing flexibility for personal pursuits.

This would suit Sports Graduates who are considering a career as a Primary or Secondary PE teacher. Throughout the placement, the successful candidate will be based in the PE department and will work closely with the sports team to support the delivery of PE lessons, swimming provision, a games programme, school fixtures and after-school sports activities. A good knowledge of a range of sports would be desirable.

### **Key responsibilities**

- Support the Director of Sport with the planning and coaching of PE lessons, games sessions and co-curricular activities for pupils as an active member of the PE & Sports Department
- Officiate sports fixtures and tournaments
- Lead training sessions
- Provide lifeguard duties (training provided if not qualified)
- To accompany teams to fixtures home and away throughout the week
- To promote professional standards, punctuality, discipline and sportsmanship with all pupils
- Actively support the school across varied departments when required

- Nurture excellent relationships with the children in your care, fostering confidence, openness and individual challenge and support.
