Key responsibilities;

- Provide cover for absent teachers across various subjects and ages between Reception and year 8
- Deliver engaging and effective lessons based on provided lesson plans and materials
- Maintain a positive and supportive classroom environment conducive to learning
- Manage student behaviour and ensure a safe and inclusive learning environment
- Collaborate with colleagues to ensure continuity of instruction and student progress

- Be aware of individual dietary and medical needs, including allergies, and of the procedures in case of emergency.
